The Central Alabama Fair Housing Center (CAFHC) seeks a motivated, mission-driven Executive Director to lead the operation and advance fair housing rights throughout Central Alabama.

Responsibilities

- Provide strategic and operational leadership for the Center.
- Serve as the primary public advocate for fair housing issues.
- Secure and expand funding through grants, partnerships, and donor development.
- Oversee programs, compliance, and day-to-day operations, including budgetary oversight.
- Work closely with the Board of Directors to ensure organizational mission and vision are accomplished.
- Build relationships with community partners and stakeholders across 29 counties.
- Supervise staff and provide direct management support.
- **Lead and grow the organization in a complex, challenging, and evolving legal and policy environment impacting fair housing enforcement**

Qualifications

- Minimum of five years of experience in civil rights or social justice advocacy.

- Minimum of three years of management and supervisory experience, including performance management and team development.
- Fundraising and grant development experience (or strong potential).
- Strong communication and advocacy skills.
- Ability to lead a remote or hybrid organization.
- Knowledge of and experience advancing fair housing laws and advocacy is preferred.
